

## **Hearthstone Championship Tour 2018 Rewards FAQ**

Players who have earned rewards from Pro Team Standings, Regional Points Leader, and Hearthstone Masters tiers as of December 1<sup>st</sup> will receive prizes as detailed in the 2018–2019 Hearthstone Championship Tour Official Rules.

### **Pro Team Standings**

Prizes for the top ten teams from Season 3 will be distributed in December.

### **Regional Points Leader**

The top four players from each region will receive cash prizes as detailed in the Official Rules. These will be distributed in December.

### **Appearance Bonus for 2-Star and 3-Star Masters**

Players who attain 2-Star and 3-Star tiers would have been eligible for appearance bonus(es) as detailed in the Official Rules. Rather than require attendance at event(s) during the Dec. 2018–March 2019 Transitional Season, the full value of this prize will be distributed in December.

- 3-Star: \$7,500
- 2-Star: \$1,000

### **Masters' Monthly Cups**

All 1-Star, 2-Star, and 3-Star Masters will be invited to participate in a online tournament with a \$5,000 prize pool. The prize breakdown will be:

- 1st - \$2,000
- 2nd - \$1,500
- 3rd - \$750
- 4th - \$750

The schedule for these tournaments will be:

- December 22 (Europe server) **NOTE: Date changed from Dec 15 to Dec 22.**
- January 5 (Asia-Pacific server)
- February 9 (Americas server)
- March 9 (Europe server)

### **End-of-Year Commemorative Item**

All players that achieve any Masters tier will receive commemorative items recognizing their achievement. These items are scheduled for distribution in April.
